## EMBARGO POLICY

Media subscribers of the *New England Journal of Medicine* must agree to honor the embargo policy covering the contents of the *Journal*. The *Journal* embargo policy is designed primarily to ensure that physician subscribers have their copy of the *Journal* at about the same time their patients hear about new research through the news media. It also gives the media time to learn about a topic, gather relevant information, and interview authors and other experts so they can accurately report complex research findings.

The *Journal* is published weekly on Thursdays, and made available online to readers at 5 p.m. Eastern time each Wednesday. By agreeing to the embargo, media subscribers pledge not to publish or broadcast stories based on *Journal* material until 5 p.m. Eastern time each Wednesday before the Thursday issue date.

Media subscribers who agree to the *Journal*'s embargo policy can access the upcoming issue online at <http://media.nejm.org> every Friday. Media subscribers are notified by e-mail when a new issue is available. The site also provides contact information for authors, to help reporters prepare stories during the embargo period.

The *Journal* embargo is a signed contract that is renewable each year. Media subscribers who intentionally break the embargo risk losing advance access to the *Journal*'s research for themselves and their organization.
